OUR STRATEGY -

HOW DO WE WANT TO LIVE IN 2025?

The Regional Development Concept (its German acronym being "REK") lays out a vision for the German-speaking Community as a frontier region, economic region, educational region, caring region and living region. The mission statement was developed in 2008, with 350 citizens, entrepreneurs, local representatives, associations, and authorities participating. It was founded on a comprehensive analysis of the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (SWOT) of the region.

Since then, numerous future-oriented projects were realized or initiated over the course of three implementation phases. Around 500 participants were involved in their development, online or at events. All of them contribute to further enhancing the quality of life in Ostbelgien. This brochure provides an overview of the projects of the third and final implementation phase until 2025.
